Submitted articles are evaluated by an Editorial Review Committee and based on relevancy, interest and readability. NGMA may accept an article as is, accept it for a rewrite, or accept it contingent on the author's revisions. All articles are subject to editing for style, clarity and space.

Journal Audience

- Provide relevant statistics and details to support your points.
- All resources should be cited at the end of the article.
- Reread submission for spelling, understanding and accuracy.

Submission Guidelines

- Articles should be between 1,500-3,500 words.
- Include a title and by-line, with a lead paragraph to compel the audience to read.
- Add author's biography consisting of two or three sentences, with author's name, title, affiliation and contact information, including email address.
- Articles should be submitted in Word®, single-spaced, and in 12 pt. Arial font.
- A stipend of \$200 will be paid for each original article accepted for publication.
- Submit articles electronically to the *Journal* Editor, Judy Hoanshelt, at judyhoanshelt@ngma.org.
- All articles become the property of the National Grants Management Association (NGMA).
