Dear NATIONAL GRANTS MANAGEMENT:

This is in response to your request dated May 24, 2017, regarding your tax-exempt status.

We issued you a determination letter in October 1994, recognizing you as tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c) (06).

Because you're not an organization described in IRC Section 170(c), donors cannot deduct contributions they make to you. You should advise your contributors that their contributions to you are not deductible.

In the heading of this letter, we indicated whether you must file an annual information return. If a return is required, you must file Form 990, 990-EZ, 990-N, or 990-PF by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required annual information return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.
